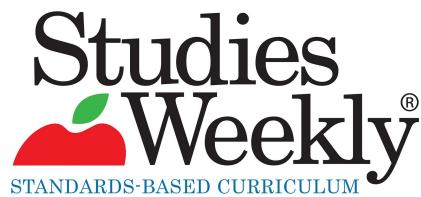
Three Hour Product Launch (up to two sessions a day)

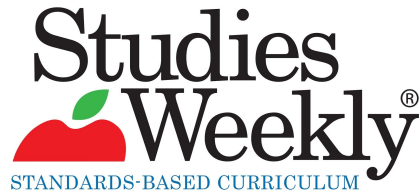
